1.	3.2 (i)	4	Projects shall be awarded amongst those in which the Bidder is lowest cost Bidder;	<p>(i) Projects shall be awarded on the basis of lowest quoted amount received for each village from the bidder.</p> <p>(ii) A Bidder can participate in all villages, however JREDA will award the maximum Ten (10) villages to one bidder subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria. In case, a bidder is lowest (L1) in more than Ten (10) villages, then the lowest bidder will be awarded first 10 villages on the basis of priority list submitted by the bidder. The remaining villages will be awarded to the next lowest bidders L2, L3, L4 and so on at the lowest (L1) price received of that village.</p> <p>(iii) If sufficient proposal is not received as per above point (ii), then JREDA reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of villages to be awarded to bidders at the lowest (L1) price received of that village subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria.</p>

Not required during the submission of tender, however bidders will have to submit commitment of Manufacturer before the date of issue of the work order.
3.	3.16		To be added.	Survey of each villages awarded to the contractor has to be done before commencement of the work. The capacity of solar pv micro/mini grid will be based on the number of household provided in the tender, however if there is large increase/decrease in number of households of a particular village, then capacity of the solar pv micro/mini grid and amount of the project will be changed on the pro-rata basis. In case, the number of the household in UEVs are found to be less than 15 household, then villages shall be electrified through Stand Alone Solar System as per the REC guideline.
