## NOTICE INVITING BIDS

### 1. Eligibility and qualification criteria

The bidder shall meet the following requirements

- Should be a registered unit of Jharkhand State, reputed supplier of SPV Water Pump sets and who manufactures of PV modules or Solar Water Pump Sets used in Solar Photovoltaic pump sets or his duly authorized agent.
- Manufacture should possess adequate in house manufacturing facilities for manufacturing PV modules or water pump sets with reliable quality control/ monitoring system.
- Manufacture must poses adequate facilities and network in the state for providing after sales services .If the bidder does not have existing network related to provide after sales service then the bidder shall submit undertaking that with in 30 days the bidder shall establish after sale service centre as per JREDS's requirement.
- Turn over during past three years should be minimum Rs Eighty lacs in any one year.

The SSI units established in Jharkhand and registered with NSIC shall be exempted from this clause .

**To meet the requirement under (i) the bidder shall furnish registration certificate clearly indicating that they are manufacture of PV Modules/ Solar Water DC Pump set as applicable. Bidder shall also submit list of manufacturing and testing facilities along with their photographs.**

2. Cost of bid documents (Non refundable) shall be deposited in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Director, Jharkhand Renewable Energy Development Agency, on any Indian Nationalized Bank/Scheduled Bank, payable at Ranchi. Bidder may purchase bid document from the office of Director, JREDA, Ashok Nagar, Ranchi, after submission of cost of bid document. Prospective bidders can also download complete bid document from the web site of JREDA [www.jreda.com](http://www.jreda.com) and may submit their bid along with the cost of bid document in Part-I envelope.



3. All bids will be received in duly sealed cover with wax within due date and time. Bids received after the due date and time shall be outright rejected.
4. Details about the date and time of issue of bid document, submission of bid opening of bid date, time, place of submission etc. are given in table 1.
5. If its happens to be holiday on the date of submission/opening of bids then the same shall be submitted/opened on next working day at the same time and the same venue.
6. No postal transaction shall be entertained for obtaining of bid documents.
7. Issuance of bid documents shall not construe that the bidders would be automatically considered qualified.
8. EMD shall be submitted in the form of Demand Draft payable at Ranchi or in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank/ Scheduled Bank along with bid.
9. Bid documents are not transferable.
10. JREDA reserve the right to distribute the total quantities to any number of bidders in the way deems fit. JREDA will adhere to fair and transparent methodology in distribution of total quantities to the successful bidders taking in to consideration of Purchase Policy 2007 of the State, their experience, past performance with JREDA in different programmes and capabilities with respect to infrastructure/ manufacturing/testing facilities & their financial strength.
11. JREDA reserve the right to amend the scope of work, accept or reject any or all the offers in part or full or cancel/withdraw the invitation for bids with or without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder/intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
12. JREDA reserve the right to postpone the date of receipt and opening of bids or cancel the bid without bearing any liability whatsoever consequent upon such decision.
13. Bidder shall submit copies of permanent Account No. (PAN)/TAN/TIN/SERVICE TAXas may be applicable.



14. The bidder shall submit the GPS Co-ordinate (Longitude & Latitude) and digital photographs of their registered office and factory campus showing their board etc.
15. If at any time any of the documents/information submitted by the bidder is found to be incorrect, false or untruthful, the bid and/or the resultant order may be summarily rejected/cancelled at the risk of bidder.

## **Section –I**

### **General Terms & Conditions**

#### **1.0 Introduction**

- 1.1** The instruction/information contained in the bid documents are for guidance and compliance of the intending bidder. Bidders are advised to obtain clarification from JREDA, if any, prior to submission of their bid, failing which it will be deemed that the stipulation made in the bid documents have been read, understood and are acceptable to the bidder.
- 1.2** Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid, journeys undertaken by them and subsequent bidding process till the award of the order to successful bidder and the JREDA shall in no case, be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

#### **2.0 Bid documents**

Tender documents shall comprise of all the documents mentioned in the table of contents of this documents. In addition to these any other documents/amendments/revisions or instructions issued by JREDA from time to time to bidders till due date of opening of the offers, shall also be deemed to be integral part of the bid document.

#### **3.0 Cost of Bid**

Non-refundable cost of bid document shall be submitted by the bidder during purchasing of bid document in the form of Demand Draft from any Indian Nationalized Bank/Scheduled Bank, drawn in favour of Director, JREDA, Ranchi. The cost of bid documents shall be Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand only)

The SSI established in Jharkhand and registered with NSIC shall be given bid documents free of cost.

Bidders downloading the bid document from JREDA web-site [www.jreda.com](http://www.jreda.com), shall submit the cost of bid at the time of submission of their bid inside Part-I envelope along with EMD failing which their bid will be summarily rejected.



#### **4.0 Earnest Money**

Bid must be accompanied with required amount as earnest money in the form of demand draft or bank guarantee drawn in favour of the director JREDA on any Indian nationalized/ Scheduled bank payable at Ranchi. This shall be enclosed with Part-I of offer (Techno-commercial bid). The earnest money deposit shall be Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only). Bidders can obtain format of Bank Guarantee form the office of JREDA during working days.

The SSI established in Jharkhand and registered with NSIC shall be exempted from Earnest Money.

- 4.1 Earnest money shall be returned to unsuccessful bidder within 60 days from the date of issue of letter of indent/work order on the successful bidder.
- 4.2 The Earnest money will be forfeited if any bidder withdraws his offer during the validity period if the successful bidder fails to furnish his acceptance of order letter within specified time or fails to start the work and execute it within the specified time frame.

#### **5.0 Submission of offer**

The offer shall be prepared by typing or printing in English with black ink on letter head of the manufacturer in consecutively numbered pages duly signed by the authorized signatory of the manufacturer with seal of the firm affixed on each page.

- 5.1 Original copy of the bid document, amendments/ revisions to bid documents issued by JREDA, (if any) shall be signed and submitted along with the bid.
- 5.2 The offer shall be free from overwriting but if any corrections are made, the same should be initiated by the person signing the offer.
- 5.3 The Part-I i.e. the Techno-Commercial bid shall be submitted complete with the followings:
  - a) Complete tender documents as purchased from JREDA or downloaded in full from JREDA web-site must be duly filled and signed (each page) by the authorized signatory with seal of the firm.
  - b) Cost of tender document (non refundable) if downloaded from JREDA web site, must be submitted in an envelope along with part-I of bid documents.
  - c) Earnest money of requisite value in one of the acceptable forms as specified shall be enclosed with part –I of the tender .





- d) Registration certificate clearly indicating that they are manufactures of PV module/DC Water pump set as applicable. The bidder shall also submit the list of in-house manufacturing and testing facility along with their photographs.
- e) A letter in confirmation of meeting the eligibility condition and qualifications.
- f) A copy Permanent Account Number (PAN), TAN,TIN,Service Tax as may be applicable..
- g) GPS Co-ordinate (Longitude & Latitude) and digital photograph of registered office and factory campus showing their board etc.
- h) Duly filled check list [5.3 (a) to (i)] shall be enclosed.
- i) Duly super scribed as part-I, Techno-commercial Bid

**5.4** The Part-II i.e the Price bid shall be submitted complete with the following:

- i) The price schedule should be duly filled both in figure and words. Each page to be duly signed by authorized person with seal of the firm. In case of any discrepancy between the price mentioned in figure and words, the price mentioned in words will be considered as final.
- ii) The price bid should not contain any technical matter or other matter except those related to price. The date of opening of the price bid will be notified after opening of Techno-Commercial bid.
- iii) The price bid should be sealed in a separate envelop duly super scribed as Part-II, Price bid.
- iv) The envelops containing Part-I i.e. Techno-commercial and Part-II i.e. Price bid shall be put inside a third envelope along with a forwarding letter. The cover should be duly super scribed with NIB No. and due date and may be submitted either personally or by registered part addressed to the director, JREDA, Plot No. 328 B, Road No. -4, Ashok Nagar, Ranchi-834005.



## **BID EVALUATION**

### **1. Part 1 (Bid Security)**

Bidders who have submitted the valid bid security as per the format and eligibility shall be considered for further evaluation. Similarly if the bid document fee has not been deposited / submitted in case of downloaded forms the Bid shall be outrightly rejected.

### **2. Opening of Technical Bid**

JREDA (The Purchase Committee) will open envelope containing the Bids in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend.

The Bidder's representatives, who are present, shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In the event of the specified day of bid opening being declared holiday for JREDA, the bids shall be opened at the appointed time and location on the next working day. On the basis of evaluation of following, only successful Bidder shall be considered for further evaluation.

### **3. Opening and Evaluation of Technical Bids**

The JREDA / Purchase Committee / Evaluation Committee would evaluate the technical bids. Bidders should be ready to get their unit inspected at a date, time in 2-3 days notice by JREDA. They are expected to reply to all the queries from the Evaluation Committee during the inspection or through email or post.

JREDA may also undertake oral clarifications with the bidders. The primary function of clarifications in the evaluation process is to clarify ambiguities not uncertainties arising out of the evaluation of the bid documents.

In order to facilitate the Technical Bid evaluation, the technical criteria laid down along with the assigned weights have been presented in (Proforma). The marking scheme presented is an indication of the relative importance of the evaluation criteria.



Bidders securing a minimum of 70% marks in the technical evaluation will only be considered for further financial bid evaluation. Bids which don't secure the minimum specified technical score will be considered technically non-responsive and hence debarred from being considered from Financial evaluation. Scores of technically qualified Bidders shall be weighed prorata on a scale of 70 and shall be carried forward for evaluation together with the scores of Financial evaluation.

#### 4. Opening and Evaluation of Financial Bids

After evaluating the Technical Bids, JREDA shall notify the bidders whose Technical Bids were considered acceptable to JREDA, indicating the date, time and place for opening of the Financial Bids.

The following points may be noted for the evaluation of the Financial Bid:

- Prices shall be written in both words and figures. In the event of difference, the price in words shall be valid and binding.
- Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If the Bidder does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid will be rejected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail.
- Any discrepancy relating to prices quoted in the offer across different sections of the bid, only prices given in the prescribed format given at Profoma 13 of this tender notice shall prevail.

Scores of the Financial evaluation would be weighed prorata on a scale of 30 with the Bidder with the **lowest commercial quote** getting 30. These financial scores would then be added up with the score of the technical evaluation and the Bidder getting the **maximum total score out of 100** would be considered as the successful bidder (i.e. L1 Bidder) and called for negotiations, if required.



### **Formula for Final Bid Evaluation is**

$$Bm = .7(TM) + .3(Fn)$$

$$Fn = (Fmin/Fb)*100$$

Where

- Bm is total marks of the bidder in consideration
- Tm is Technical Marks of the bidder in consideration
- Fn is Normalized financial score of the bidder in consideration
- Fb is Evaluated Cost of bidder under consideration
- Fmin is Minimum evaluated cost of any bidder

JREDA reserves the right to negotiate with the Bidder whose proposal has been ranked first on the basis of best value.

### **5.5 Scope of work**

The scope of work includes manufacture, testing, supply, installation, testing, commissioning and 2/5 years CMC of Solar Photo-Voltaic pump sets (surface and submersible) of 900 Wp, 1200Wp, 1800 Wp and 2400 Wp in selected regions of Jharkhand State. (Current Utility :- 8 Nos. of SVP Pump set in Drinking Water and Sanitation Department, Pakur District, Jharkhand State.

### **5.6 Price**

The bidder shall quote his price as per schedule of items of work. The contract price & units rates shall be firm and bindings and shall not be subject to any variation except for statutory variation of taxes and duties during the contractual completion period. The price shall be inclusive of all taxes, duties and levies including Jharkhand VAT etc. as on the date opening of tender. The price shall also include manufacturing, inspection, supply, transport, insurance, handling erection at site, testing, commissioning & 2/5 year CMC. All applicable charges for taking necessary clearance such as commercial tax, road permit/ forest department etc. wherever required are to be included in the contract price.



### **5.7 Performance Guarantee**

The contract shall furnish Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized Bank/ Scheduled Bank for an amount equate to 5% of the order value against performance guarantee for the due & faithful performance of the agreement along with their terms and conditions.

On due completion of work in all respects the earnest money and all payments due will be returned to the contract, without any interest on presentation of an absolute 'No Demand Certificate' form JREDA, provided always that JREDA shall be entitled to retain, deduct, set off or adjust any claim against the contractor from the money deposited with or becoming payable to JREDA.

### **5.8 Payment terms and conditions**

Subject to any deduction which JREDA may be authorized to make under this contract, the contractor shall be entitled to payment as follows :-

An amount equivalent to 95% of the contract value of the items will be paid after completion of supply, installation, and commissioning. Another 5% of the contract value will be released after two years from the date of commissioning. However, 5% of the contract value will be released against submission of Bank Guarantee.

### **5.9 Dispatch Instructions**

The manufacturers Test Report will be submitted for equipments dispatched to the site for setting up of SPV Water Pumpset. Manufacturer's test report for items to be dispatched will be submitted to JREDA. JREDA reserves the right to get the equipment/material tested by the consultant.

### **6.0 Liquidated damages for delay in completion**

If the supplier fails in the due performance of the contract to deliver any part of the equipment or complete the work within the time fixed under the contract or any extension thereof granted to him by JREDA and/or to fulfill his obligations in time under the contract, he shall be liable to pay to JREDA as pre-agreed liquidated damages a sum equivalent to  $\frac{1}{2}$  (0.5) % of total contract value per week of such delay or part thereof, subject to maximum of 5% of the total contract value. The liquidated damages for delayed completion shall be recovered from the supplier's bill or security deposit.



### **6.1 Insurance**

The supplier shall arrange for transit and erection insurance of the materials & equipments for setting up of SPV Water Pump sets at his own cost. It will not be mandatory

### **6.2 Assignment/ Sub-letting**

The contract may not without the prior consent in writing of the purchase, assign or sublet or transfer his contract or a substantial part thereof provide that any such consent shall not relieve the contractor from any obligation, duty or responsibility under the contract.

### **6.3 Force Majeure conditions**

In the event of either party being rendered unable by force majeure to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under this agreement, relative obligation of the party affected by such force majeure shall be treated as suspended during which force majeure clause last.

The term force majeure shall have herein mean riots (other than among the contractor's employee), civil commotion, war (whether declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemies hostilities, rebellion, insurrection, military coup to usurp power, act of god such as earthquake, lightening, floods, fires not caused by contractor's negligence and other cause which the contractor has no control and accepted as such by the Director, JREDA, whose decision shall be final and binding.

### **6.5 Completeness of Tender**

All fittings, assemblies, accessories, hardware items, civil & electrical works & safety devices as required shall be deemed to have been included in the tender, whether such items are specially mentioned in the BOQ are not.

### **6.6 Compliance with regulations**

The contractor shall comply with all applicable laws or ordinances, codes approved standards, rules and regulations and shall procure all necessary municipal other statutory bodies and government permits & licenses etc. at his own cost. The contractor shall leave the purchaser and the Director, JREDA, harmless as a result of any infractions thereof.

### **6.7 Award of contract**

The contract/order shall be awarded to techno-commercially acceptable & lowest evaluated bidder as per the Purchase Policy of the state.



### **6.8 Agreement**

The supplier have to enter into an agreement in the office of the Director, JREDA, in prescribed format before commencement of supply.

### **6.9 Arbitration**

All disputes would be settled within Ranchi jurisdiction of court of law only. All arbitration cases would only be settled under Arbitration & conciliation Act but at Ranchi only.
